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Simulation LaunchPad Course Prospectus

The Simulation Launchpad course is run over two days in-person and is designed to ensure solid basic educational theory and practical concepts related to simulation-based education before moving into practice. The course facilitators are experienced South African simulation educators.

This course will be pediatric focused to create a community of simulation educators to grow simulation-based learning in clinical environments.

Vision: A candidate is able to return to their place of work and run simple clinical simulations.

Learning outcomes:

- Understanding of simulation instructional design
- Overview of the breadth of simulation
- Able to use suitable debriefing tool
- Feels sense of simulation community, seeks simulation mentor & shared resources

On day one we will explore what simulation is, key concepts on facilitation and how to deliver scenarios, scenario design and the debrief and implementation of simulation-based education. The second day will be spent practicing simulation delivery and debriefing in groups, with facilitation and feedback from the instructors.

Participants will receive:

- Two days of in-person training
- A digital course handbook with additional resources ahead of time to prepare
- A course workbook
- University of Cape Town course certificate
- 16 CPD points
- Tea and lunch on both days
- Access to a network of simulation educators to continue development and ongoing support
