PRIVACY NOTICE

You are at the heart of everything we do. That is why we have created this privacy notice to help you understand how we collect, use, and protect your personal information. This privacy notice will help you understand how we do that. This notice may change, and we will update the date at the top of this page if it does. 1. YOUR RIGHTS AND PREFERENCES

You have the right to:

- ask what we know about you;
- ask what personal information we sent to our suppliers, service providers, or anyone else;
- ask us to update, correct or delete any out-of-date or incorrect personal information we have about you;

When you apply to study at UCT, we collect information about:

Who you are: like your name, address, date of birth, nationality, race and gender, identity document, home language, passport, study permit, permanent residence.	We use this information to make decisions about your application, for internal planning purposes, to obtain funding and subsidies from government. We also need to verify some of the information you share with us, and we may use third-party service providers to help us. We use applicants' and students' information to create an institutional profile for obtaining funding from government. We report to schools about applicants.
How to reach you: like telephone number(s) and email address.	We use this information to stay in touch with you and send you important information.
How we might assist you: like your disability information.	We use this information to determine whether you need support for a disability.
What your background is: like education and employment history.	And, finally, there are some things we ask to help us get to know you better before we decide to admit you.
Manage our relationship: We collect and use information like banking details, dietary requirements and participation in sports and cultural activities	There is information we need to ensure that we can deliver the services you signed up for. For example, we need to communicate with you, bill you, provide catering in residences and to process applications for a deferment or leave of absence.

We generate information about you in the form of records of:

- how you perform academically;

4. HOW WE SHARE YOUR INFORMATION

We will only share your personal information with others if it is necessary to manage our relationship with you or to ensure that our business runs smoothly. We only share the information that the service provider needs - nothing more.

We may share your information with service providers to help us:

- communicate with you;
- verify your qualifications;

- manage academic transcripts, events, career and other services;
- monitor the effectiveness of our services;
- manage operations, for e.g., accountants, auditors and professional advisors; and manage our buildings and facilities

Whether our service providers are in South Africa or other countries, they must agree to keep your information as safe and confidential as we do. And they may only use it for the reason we share it with them. We make sure that we have the necessary contracts in place before we share your information.

WE DON'T HOARD YOUR INFORMATION

We will not keep your information for longer than we need to for business reasons or longer than the law requires.

WE DO OUR BEST TO KEEP YOUR INFORMATION SECURE 6.

We have reasonable security measures in place to protect personal information from:
